

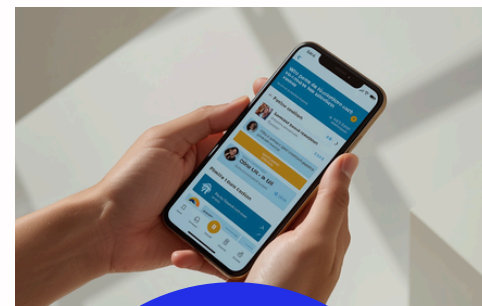

# UNLOCK DIGI Newsletter

Erasmus+ KA210-ADU | Issue #1 | LTT1 · Bacău, Romania · 4-6 February 2026

The first transnational Learning, Teaching and Training event of the UNLOCK DIGI project has taken place. Partners from Romania, Czechia and Türkiye spent three intensive days in Bacău focused on building better digital literacy for Roma and immigrant adults across Europe.



## DAY 1 · 4 FEBRUARY Methodology & Lesson Design

The opening day established a shared foundation — partners aligned on project objectives O1-O3 and dived into pedagogical principles.

- Partner Introductions: Each institution presented its work; the consortium reconfirmed objectives together.
- Round Table on Adult Learning: Peer exchange on andragogy, gamification, and digital storytelling.
- Mobile Toolkit Highlights: WhatsApp groups, QR codes, and Kahoot in image mode for low-literacy contexts.
- Design a Digital Lesson Workshop: Five rapid prototyping challenges completed.

## DAY 2 · 5 FEBRUARY Field Day — School & Community.

The most immersive day brought partners into school and community settings, engaging nearly 45 participants.

- School Welcome & Tour: Teachers, parents, mediators joined discussions on media literacy and digital security.
- "The Phone, My Friend" Questionnaire: Roma parents completed 20 questions on digital lives.
- Google Lens Demonstration: Practical tutorial on visual information access.
- Training Simulation: Afternoon session with structured peer feedback.

## DAY 3 · 6 FEBRUARY — Civic Tech, Focus Group & Action Plans

The final day explored civic impact — how digital tools connect communities to public services. Ghişeu.ro and e-Devlet presented as examples. 12 school mediators engaged in a focus group on training needs. Each partner drafted a community digital-literacy roadmap, and Europass-aligned certificates were awarded.

"Digital literacy for our communities is not about teaching computers. It is about access, confidence, safety, family support and active participation in community life."
